About Rogers Rookie Tour:

 - > Boys and girls up to the age of 18 are eligible to play in Rogers Rookie Tour events
 - > All events in the Rogers Rookie Tour are non-elimination tournaments
 - > Each player is guaranteed a minimum of three matches

> Players receive a prize at each Rogers Rookie Tour (RRT) event. Players can compete in multiple events to collect all available prizes.

> To be a part of the RRT and receive a prize, players must be **registered as a RECREATIONAL MEMBER** of your Provincial Tennis Association.
